This Lenten Season

This week marked the official beginning of Spring! And after the winter we have had I am especially grateful. There is nothing like a string of snow storms to make us appreciate warm weather when it finally arrives. Seasons were woven into the fabric of God's creation. Our lives are marked by different seasons as well. The liturgical (or church) calendar is also comprised of seasons. Right now, as you already know, we are in the middle of Lent – a time of fasting, purification and preparation for the coming of Holy Week and, of course, Easter Sunday.

This year, as a church, we have planned a number of special events and services to observe this incredibly important time of year. Several will be familiar, but some will be new. All have been planned very intentionally to help us EXPERIENCE the journey together – one that travels through the wilderness, to the cross and, ultimately, to the resurrection of our Savior. I don't want anyone to miss out, so here is a brief outline of what we will be up to – together...

Ash Wednesday (March 6) - we opened the chapel as a place for prayer and receiving of ashes.

Every Sunday During Lent – Deborah Myers and I are leading a Sunday School class in Wolf Hall from 10:10 – 10:55 (between services). Class is very prayer centered and conversation is based on the Lenten devotion we purchased for everyone – *Leaning In, Letting Go.* **We still have a few copies available if you didn't get one.** Come every Sunday or just one. This has been VERY powerful so far!

Palm Sunday (April 14) – We will have a joint-service at 10:00 (Sunday School at 9:00). This service will begin with celebration and a palm procession with the children. Next, we will have a reenactment of the Last Supper (with costumes and a thirteen-member cast). The service will conclude in silence and our cross will be draped in black. These, as you may have guessed, are to acknowledge the events of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. After all, we cannot get to Easter Sunday without Good Friday. And without the crucifixion there can be no resurrection.

A 24-Hour Prayer Vigil will be held in the chapel from Friday, April 19 at 7:00 pm – Saturday April 20 at 7:00 pm. A sign-up sheet for 30 or 60-minute time slots is posted at the Connection Center in the Annex.

Easter Sunday (April 21)!!! We will serve breakfast from 8:00 – 9:30. Sunday School classes will meet from 9:00 - 9:50. At 9:15 we will have an Easter Egg Hunt (for children in preschool to third-grade). At 10:00 we will have an amazing service, which will include baptisms, an opportunity to join the church, and (for the first time ever) music led by the choir and the band together! I am VERY, VERY EXCITED for this service and I want to encourage EVERYONE to bring multiple guests with them.

My vision for this service is 500 in attendance – so I am serious when I say, "bring guests!"

As I mentioned already, I am rather excited. I need to be careful to not get ahead of myself though. This Lenten Season is not something to be rushed – for any of us. As we continue this journey together may we be reminded that we are in this together. And for that we can all be especially grateful.
