That All May Be One

I listen to the news a lot while I am driving. Maybe I'm an optimist, but I keep listening and keep hoping to hear some really good news one of these days – especially regarding things in Washington D.C. Like many of you (I'm sure), I'm still waiting...

Don't worry, I'm not about to get political – I just wish there was more unity among the leaders of our country. I think about how blessed we are as a nation and how much good we could do if less time and energy was spent arguing and pointing fingers. I'll be honest – the whole thing makes me very sad.

Sometimes I feel like getting on a plane and heading to The Hill with a big sign that says, "Can't We All Just Get Along!" I know this wouldn't help though - so I don't. I've thought about writing a letter to someone important (and then getting a bunch of signatures on it), but somehow I doubt that would change much either.

When my thoughts drift in this direction, I try to remind myself of something I heard years ago, "Focus on what you CAN do - instead of what you CAN'T." For many of us, this means striving for unity and making a positive difference in our families, in our community, and in our church. This might not generate national news coverage, but it's still incredibly important. And I think Jesus would agree.

Some of our leaders (at FCC) have been reading a book entitled, "Doing Church as a Team." This book explores God's desire to use us (and the unique gifts he has blessed us with) to accomplish amazing things. The author (Wayne Cordeiro) also explores how important unity is to Jesus and to God. Through the words of scripture (recorded in John 17), we get to overhear a very intimate prayer offered by Jesus to his Father. Listen to what Jesus says...

"I do not ask for these (members of the church) only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I am you, that they (the members of the church) may also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

This particular prayer caught my attention years ago, but Cordeiro takes it a step further in a way that stopped me in my tracks. He speculates casually on the number of prayers Christians have asked Jesus to answer over the centuries and then poses this question, "What if we, for once, could actually answer one of Jesus' prayers?"

Wow! What an incredible idea! Jesus has blessed us in SO MANY ways - wouldn't it be amazing to strive for something that blesses Him? I don't know about you, but if this were the only thing that unity accomplished (pleasing Jesus) it would be enough for me. As I re-read the prayer though, it sounds like unity among the people of God is something that everyone (as in EVERYONE) ends up of benefitting from.

Hmmm... I might have to turn the radio off and ponder what part I might be able to play in something like this. You are (of course), welcome to join me.

<u>12:00-1:00</u> Deliver home from second service and return bus to church parking lot.


