On A Mission!

Ever since we humans started causing trouble for ourselves (see Genesis 3) God has been On A Mission to bring Hope and Help and Healing to his people. This is the same mission God entrusted to Jesus when he came to earth. This is the same mission Jesus entrusted to his Disciples in John 20:21 when he said, "As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you."

A few weeks ago, we began a new sermon series entitled *On A Mission*. In this series, we have been taking a closer look at the ministry of Jesus and what his mission means for us as Disciples of Christ today. You probably remember (from our Bible 101 series) that Jesus' public ministry (leading up to his crucifixion and resurrection) had two primary objectives: 1) To help people PHYSICALLY (he did this through healing the sick and the lame, feeding the hungry and even raising a few people from the dead); and, 2) To help people SPIRITUALLY (he did this through teaching and preaching the message of the Gospel).

Since these were the primary objectives of Jesus' mission and ministry, these are the primary objectives of our mission and ministry. I believe God has a unique call on each of our lives (a plan and a purpose within his mission that no one can fulfill but us). That can be kind of overwhelming (even scary) to consider, but God never asks more of us than we can handle (especially when we choose to depend on his strength and his resources).

I find encouragement in Jesus' invitation to follow his lead one step at a time (we don't do it all at once). The Holy Spirit guides and comforts us along the way. And God gives us strength and grace for the journey. Following Jesus always results in blessing – for others and also for ourselves. And when a church or a community of faith has enough individuals commit to following Jesus' call on their life – possibility and potential grow exponentially!

Over the next few weeks, we will be talking about specific ways to support the mission of Jesus through the ministries of First Christian Church (with our time, our talents and our treasures). The opportunities we will be focusing on will be small things (*like giving an extra five dollars a week or greeting people on Sunday mornings*). Commitments like these might not seem like much, but they really, REALLY add up!

My prayer (for all of us) over the next few weeks, is that we really try to tune into the leading of the Holy Spirit in our hearts. And when we feel a little nudge, I pray we have the courage to follow where He leads.

NOMINATION BALLOT FOR 2019 BOARD MEMBERS

Please nominate one person for each vacancy. We need to elect one (1) **TRUSTEE**; five (5) **ELDERS**; up to fifteen (15) **DEACONS** (8-3 year terms, 2-2 year terms and 5-1 year terms); and fourteen (20) **DEACONESSSES** (12-3 year, 6-2-year term and 2-1 year term). No person can serve in two positions at the same time. **Those going off the Board this year are not eligible to be re-elected for one full year, unless they have been filling a vacancy.** EVERY person nominated will be asked whether or not he or she will serve and if the answer is affirmative, will have his or her name placed on the election ballot. Officers of the Church

Qualifications

1. Every officer shall have been a member of this church, in good standing, for at least one year prior to nomination, and have demonstrated support of the church by regular worship attendance and stewardship, i.e. financial, time and/or talents.
2. No one shall hold simultaneously more than one elected position as an officer of the church.
3. Any officer having served three years in that office shall not be eligible for re-election until one year has elapsed. Officers appointed to fill vacancies shall be eligible for election at the next regular congregational election. (See Article IV, Item 8, of this Constitution).
4. To qualify for the office of Elder or Trustee, one must first have served one full term as Deaconess or Deacons.

The following officers shall be elected by and from the membership:

1. **Elders:** Not to exceed twelve in number, one-third of whom shall be elected each year for a term of three years.
2. **Deaconess:** Not to exceed thirty-six in number, one-third of whom shall be elected each year for a term of three years
3. **Deacon:** Not to exceed twenty-four in number, one-third of whom shall be elected each year for a term of three years
4. **Trustee:** Three in number, one of whom shall be elected each year or a term of three years.

Those who, by service and consecration to the church, merit the honor may be nominated as Honorary officers by the Board of Elders, and confirmed by a majority of the Church Board. While the help and advice of these emeritus officers would be appreciated, they shall be relieved of all regular duties and shall vote only as members of the congregation.

Duties

The **Elders**, in cooperation with the Ministry Teams, shall promote the growth and welfare of the church by giving thoughtful consideration to policies that will enable it to fulfill its complete mission; exemplify by word and deed the missionary, evangelistic, educational and stewardship responsibilities of the membership; give encouragement to the members with respect to regular attendance at the Lord's Supper and visiting the sick; counsel the morally faltering and spiritually indifferent; serve at the Lord's Table; and perform such other duties as may be assigned. The Elders will also act as a Ministry Team for congregational concerns and as a pastoral relations Ministry Team for the congregation and for the senior minister. The Elders will be responsible for an annual written evaluation of the Senior Minister, as well as any special interim evaluations deemed necessary. This annual review will take place in the month of the anniversary date of the initial hiring of the Senior Minister. The Elders will be responsible for preparing an annual employment agreement and a current job description for the Senior Minister.

The **Deacons** and **Deaconesses**, in cooperation with the ministry teams, shall give advice and service in the business affairs and program activities of the church; and shall serve the church in either worship service by participating in some or all of the following: assisting in the greeting and ushering of the worshippers; assume responsibility for the preparation and care of the communion service and/or distribution of the Lord's Supper and receiving the offerings. Other duties shall include, but not be limited to: assisting in financial canvasses and visiting projects; ministering to the families in times of sickness and bereavement; and ministering to the needy.

The **Trustees**, under the direction of the Church Board and subject to review by the membership, shall act as the legal agents of the church in all business matters; hold legal title to all church property and handle all business transactions related thereto; manage the investment of all gifts, bequests, endowments, and trusts; be responsible for the preservation and orderly safekeeping of all business papers and documents of the church; and perform such duties as are required by the laws of the State of Kansas.

Duties of the Church Board

The Church Board is charged by the membership with the responsibility of adopting and overseeing the programs of the church, and with conducting the church's business affairs, exercising control of expenditures of all funds of the church derived from (1) pledges and offerings; (2) gifts, bequests, endowments and trusts; and (3) Bible School Treasury offerings (commonly referred to as Church School, and hereafter this name will be used in this Constitution and By-Laws). The Church Board shall function according to such general policies as have been set forth in this Constitution and By-Laws. The actions of the Church Board are at all times subject to review by the membership.

The Church Board shall consider actions which further the work of the church, and approve such actions receiving majority votes which are within its constitutional authority. The Church Board shall recommend to the congregation actions which require a congregational vote. All business meetings of the Church Board and of the congregation shall be conducted according to Robert's Rules of Order.

The Church Board shall not take final action on any motion involving the expenditures of unbudgeted monies until the following requirements have been met:

- a) The expenditure has been approved by the Stewardship Ministry Team.
- b) The method of funding has been determined.
- c) The proposal to be voted upon has been announced at the previous regular Church Board Meeting.

The Church board shall approve an annual budget for all funds under its control and then submit it to the congregation for ratification.

The Church Board shall seek approval of the congregation for the expenditure of any sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more which is not provided for in the budget previously approved by the congregation, except in the instance of monies spent for emergency property repairs.

The Church Board shall make an annual written report to the membership setting forth clearly the work of the Ministry Teams, including: (1) reports for all income and expenditures of funds compared to the budget, and (2) year-end fund balances. This annual report shall be issued within forty-five days after the close of the church's fiscal year.

The Church Board shall secure and review the annual audit, to be made by an independent agency, of all financial records pertaining to all funds under its control.
