Coffee Group: Meets Thursdays at 10:00 AM at Paolucci's Restaurant-113 S. 3rd St.

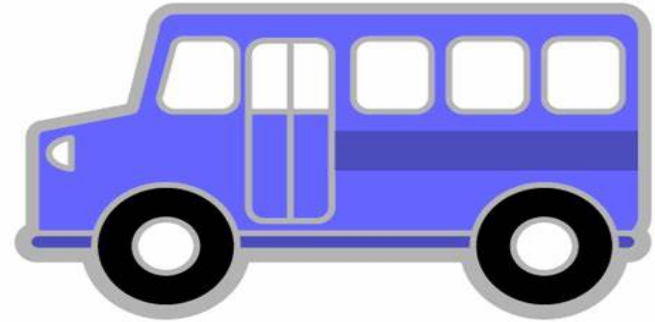
CWF Sewing Group: Join our sewing group every second Thursday of the month from 8:30 AM – 3 PM. We meet in Wolf Hall (basement).
