Lessons We Can Learn From COVID

I still remember the first time I heard the word COVID.

It was on a news podcast I listen to a lot when I am driving.

I had no idea (at the time) how much the world was about to change, but it has.

And we are still a long way away from being on the other side.

The suffering and havoc that COVID has created is (in many ways) unprecedented.

For that reason (among others), it is hard to believe that

The past few months have taught me some valuable lessons though. I have also talked to others who feel the same way. Below is a short list of the kinds of lessons I'm talking (and hearing) about -

Lessons We Can Learn From COVID:

- 1. **Life is full of SIMPLE BLESSINGS for us to enjoy!** Worshipping together on Sunday mornings, going out to eat, spending time with friends & loved ones, and (frequently taken for granted until now) toilet paper! Of course, these are just a few.
- 2. Nothing is more important in life than FAITH & FAMILY. This is one that I have heard again and again. Many of us spend our lives trying to accomplish so many different tasks that we reach the end of the day (or the end of our days) only to realize that we have neglected these two (most important of all) PRIORITIES. Every day we are blessed with is another chance to start DOING THIS ONE RIGHT.
- 3. There is very little in life that we can actually CONTROL. These past few months have been an absolute whirlwind of ups and downs! So many things have happened that none of us could or would have planned. Learning to be flexible (if we don't want to break) is vital & so is being intentional about the things we do have some control over (our actions & our attitude).
- 4. **GOD IS GOOD!** It is amazing to me how naturally & how quickly we turn to God in the midst of difficult times. The comfort God provides is reassuring, but we are also reminded that God wants to share the good times with us as well!
- 5. **THIS TOO SHALL PASS**. We are not there yet, but a little bit of time in our Bibles (and a few moments reflecting on our own lives) confirms that God will bring us through (just as He always has) at just the right time and in the way that only He can.

PEACE THAT PASSES UNDERSTANDING.

I also pray that we might continue to learn ALL THAT WE can from this experience.

Atchison County Food Pantry is continuing our drive-through food pantry every two weeks on Friday afternoons. We believe this is the safest way to operate for both our clients and volunteers at this time. At our last drive-through on July 3rd, we served 129 households and 392 individuals in those households. We provide each household around 25 lbs. of staples, plus two kinds of meat, fresh produce, bakery and deli products from Feeding America. We work with a very dedicated crew of six or seven individuals who prepare these boxes, and twelve or thirteen volunteers to staff the drive-throughs. Parker Kottman is our newest volunteer, and is proving to be a hard worker.

On Thursday, July 30th, we will have a special distribution of food and produce from the Mobile Pantry of Second Harvest, our Food Bank. This distribution will be from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM.

If you would like to make a food or supplies donation, we are always in need of canned vegetables and fruit, hot or cold cereals, pancake mix and syrup, peanut butter and jellies or jams, spaghetti or elbow macaroni and spaghetti sauce, rice and beans, soups, ramen noodles, toilet paper, and laundry or dish detergent. Cash donations and Thrivent cards are always welcome, too. The Thrivent Cards are especially helpful as they help us conserve our cash. You may leave your donations outside the Church office, which is currently open until 2:00 PM, and 4:00 PM on Wednesdays.



FCC COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

As voted upon and adopted by FCC Board on June 9th, 2020

The following set of COVID-19 safety protocols has been developed for the safety of our congregants. These protocols are subject to change at the discretion of the Board and without notice.

- 1. There will be one entrance to the building with signs posted for pre-screening purposes. (See attached sign)
 - Volunteers will be posted to screen entry, open door, provide masks, etc.
- 2. People gain entrance to services upon:
 - Screening for COVID symptoms, simple "yes" to posted questions
 - Temperature taken and less than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit
 - Wearing a mask (provided, if needed)
- 3. Pre-packaged communion will be dispersed as people enter by someone wearing gloves. Any packaging will be disposed of by the individual after their use in the containers provided.
- 4. Congregants will practice preventative guidelines within the building:
 - Frequent hand-washing
 - Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth
 - Avoid close contact with others
 - Practice social distancing (6ft of separation)
 - Cover coughs and sneezes
- 5. Seating in the sanctuary will begin 5 rows back from the altar and be 6 feet apart.
- 6. There will be no congregation singing for either service until further notice.
- 7. All Pens/Pencils, Bibles, Hymns, and Sign-in Registers will be removed from the pews.
- 8. An offering "bucket" will be placed at the back of the sanctuary or in the annex to collect an offering.
- 9. The facility will be cleaned and disinfected after each gathering following CDC guidelines, with special attention given to high traffic areas.
- 10. Service times have been altered to give time for cleaning in between services, as well, limit exposure for those that are high risk.




Covid-19 Screening Questions:
