FCC Youth Group KC Mission Trip

August 19-21, 2022

17 members of the First Christian Church Youth Group and 5 adult sponsors spent the weekend of August 19-21, 2022 in the greater Kansas City area. The purpose of the trip was to volunteer their time and energy to help others.

Friday evening, they set up camp at the Heartland Center in Parkville, MO and enjoyed exploring the campground and a campfire with s'mores.

Saturday morning, they helped the Liberty Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) "Johnny's Cafe" deliver and pass out 370 meals. (The youth had an opportunity to taste the delicious food being made as the church fed them before the youth went on to their next service project.)

Saturday afternoon, the youth volunteered at Harvesters in KC. They sorted approximately 3 pallets or 124 cases of cucumbers. (Harvesters provides food and related household products to more than 760 nonprofit agencies including emergency food pantries, community kitchens, homeless shelters, children's homes and others.)

Saturday evening the youth had the opportunity to attend the Ethnic Enrichment Festival which focuses on the traditional cultures found in Kansas City and its surrounding metro area. They enjoyed music and food from different countries.

Sunday morning the youth returned to Liberty Christian Church for worship service where Pastor Culver included our youth in his blessing for the school year (Pastor Culver was a minister at FCC several years ago).

After worship service, the youth and sponsors went to Main Event for pizza and games.

Sunday afternoon, they went to their last service project of the weekend, volunteering at KC Pet Project (they care for over 14,000 animals a year). They made treats, cleaned and helped inventory items. All would have liked to take a new friend home as their kennels were full with adoptable pets.
