"Change in inevitable. Growth is optional." John Maxwell

We have all experienced change at some point in our lives and know that sometimes it can be a difficult thing. We are often faced with the choice to embrace change and grow with it even when it becomes uncomfortable or we can choose to reject the change. This played out a few years ago in my life when the schools shut down and the kids had to do school from home. I sat down at the kitchen table to help my daughter with math and realized a lot had changed in the way that math is now done. Did you know that they have changed how math is done? When I sat down to help her, I was able get the correct answer using the method I had learned in school but could not teach her through the process she had learned. I then had a choice to attempt to learn the new process and accept the change or just try to teach her using the old method. Knowing it was best for my daughter and her learning process I embraced the change and attempted to learn a new process.

Growth is learning a new process and adapting to change. I would say that we here at First Christian have experienced growth in many areas over the last little bit. Growth can have challenges that come with it, but not all challenges are bad and some are really exciting. One of the major areas of growth we have seen at FCC is in the Youth Group. The Children & Youth Ministries Team have done a phenomenal job at engaging our youth and growing the youth group. The youth have been taking on an average of about 20 to 25 teens on their outings. With this growth we needed to have a vehicle that would carry a lot of youth and a vehicle that the sponsors were comfortable driving. With this growth a few months ago the church board and Christian Education team approved the use of McAdow funds to purchase a 15-passenger van.

This van is going to be such a blessing to both our youth and our church community. Again, we recognize growth and change can be hard but it can also be a very exciting thing. I ask and pray that you will continue to support the growth and changes that are taking place at First Christian Church.
